And since power flows in a more direct path from the engine to all four wheels, it works with brilliant efficiency for secure grip and quicker response to slippage.

#### Quicker Response


There are only four small patches of rubber that keep you in control of your vehicle. The more your tires are engaged, the more control you have. Subaru keeps more power routed to all four tires than some other systems that only fully engage all wheels as a reaction to slippage that has already occurred.

#### Efficient Design

Because power in some adapted systems must route through extra components, these systems not only sacrifice efficiency, but also can incur more wear and tear. Subaru routes power directly from the engine to all four wheels to keep components—and frictional power losses—to a minimum.

## **Engine and Suspension**

An SUV doesn't have to drive like one. The remarkable agility of the Subaru Forester begins with its smooth-revving SUBARU BOXER® engine. A lower center of gravity means that while supplying clean and efficient power, this engine design actually helps maintain vehicle balance. 
